Why did God do it?

What do we get from it?

Ephesians 1:7-14, Romans 5:8-10, 1 John 1:9, Romans 8:15, 12:1-2

- \checkmark Forgiveness = Our <u>debt</u> was <u>paid</u> by someone else.
- ✓ God's will = We have been <u>chosen</u> to be <u>set apart.</u>
- ✓ *Relationship* = Jesus gave his life $\frac{\text{for us}}{\text{for us}}$, **AND** $\frac{\text{to us}}{\text{to us}}$.
- \checkmark Guarantee = We are <u>sons</u> and <u>daughters</u> of the <u>King</u>.
- ✓ Inheritance = We are <u>citizens</u> of <u>Heaven</u>.
